

InterGuard Network Deployment

Awareness Technologies can build an unattended executable for your InterGuard account. This unattended executable does not require any user interaction and will not display any visible items. It installs and registers the SONAR client software automatically and silently. We offer an unattended executable so that you may have flexibility in your deployment options.

There are a variety of tools that an administrator can use to deploy executables to computers on their network. Most methods will work fine with the SONAR unattended executable. We have had much success using PsExec from System Internals. This is a free lightweight tool, and it does not require anything to be installed on the target (remote) computer(s) prior to your deployment. You can find more information on PsExec here:

There are a couple of requirements for using PsExec; these also apply to most other deployment tools. The target (remote) computer must be connected to the same network as the source computer (the one being used to deploy). You will need to know the computer's name or IP address. You will also need to have credentials for a domain or local user account that has administrative abilities at the target computer.
